GOOD NEWS ON VOCATIONS FRONT FOR DIOCESE OF CLOGHER

Two young men from County Monaghan have answered the call to share in the mission of the Church by recently beginning formation and academic programmes which will, hopefully, lead to them being ordained priests for the Diocese of Clogher over the coming years. In addition, another man, from Enniskillen, is undertaking formation and academic preparation for the permanent diaconate. This good news comes as the Catholic Church throughout the world marks an Extraordinary Month of Mission, declared by Pope Francis in order to focus on the vital contribution that all Catholics can play in proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ and making his message known to all people, at home and elsewhere. The two students for priesthood are Stephen Sherry from Tullycorbet parish who has begun academic studies and formation at St Patrick's College, Maynooth, and Matthew Newell from Clones parish who has commenced his propaedeutic programme at the English College of St Alban at Valladolid in Spain. In addition, Paul Flynn, Choir Director at St Michael's Parish, Enniskillen, is also progressing his studies and formation for the permanent diaconate in Clogher. The Dublin-born man is undertaking his studies alongside others through the programme put in place in Belfast by the Diocese of Down and Connor.
