**GOLDEN JUBILEE:** Today 14 July, Bishop Liam MacDaid, Bishop Emeritus of Clogher, will mark the **50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his ordination to priesthood** with a special Mass of Thanksgiving at 4pm in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan. Bishop MacDaid was ordained at St Patrick's College, Maynooth on 15 June 1969. A native of Bundoran, Co Donegal, Bishop Liam served as Bishop of Clogher from July 2010 until his retirement on health grounds in October 2016. Everyone is very welcome to attend the Mass and all are invited to the nearby Hillgrove Hotel for refreshments after the Mass. Bishop MacDaid will preside in the sanctuary. Bishop Larry Duffy, will be the chief celebrant of the Mass. Other celebrants include Bishop Joseph Duffy, Bishop Emeritus of Clogher, Bishop Leo O'Reilly, Bishop Emeritus of Kilmore, priests of the Diocese of Clogher and a number of visiting priests. In the congregation will be family members and many friends and associates of Bishop MacDaid. The music will be led by the St Macartan's Cathedral Choir, under the direction of Deirdre Macklin. Since his ordination, Bishop MacDaid has served the people of the diocese as a teacher, a leader in the field of education, as a diocesan official and as bishop. Above all, he has served countless numbers of people as a priest and it is this priestly ministry which the people of the diocese and his many friends will celebrate and give thanks for.

**REEK SUNDAY 2019 – SUNDAY 28 JULY** The annual national pilgrimage to Croagh Patrick 'Reek Sunday' takes place on 28 July. Mass will be celebrated on the summit of the mountain on the hour with the first Mass at 8:00am and the last Mass at 2:00pm. Confessions will be available on the summit from 7:30am to 2:00pm.

**THE LITURGICAL FEAST OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL** is celebrated on 16 July. **Our Lady of Mount Carmel** is the title given to the **Blessed Virgin Mary** in her role as **patroness** of the **Carmelite Order**. The first Carmelites were Christian **hermits** living on **Mount Carmel** in the **Holy Land** during the late 12th and early to mid-13th century. They built in the midst of their hermitages a **chapel** which they dedicated to the Blessed Virgin, whom they conceived of in chivalric terms as the "Lady of the place." Since the 15th century, popular devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel has centred on the Brown **Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel**. Traditionally, Mary is said to have given the Scapular to an early Carmelite - St **Simon Stock** (1165-1265) with the following promise, saying : "Receive, My beloved son, this habit of thy order: this shall be to thee and to all Carmelites a privilege, that whosoever dies clothed in this shall never suffer eternal fire .... It shall be a sign of salvation, a protection in danger, and a pledge of peace." *Prayer of our Lady of Carmel. "O most beautiful flower of Mt. Carmel, fruitful vine, splendour of Heaven, Blessed Mother of the Son of God, Immaculate Virgin, assist me in my necessity. O Star of the Sea, help me and show me you are my Mother. O Holy Mary, Mother of God, Queen of Heaven and earth, I humbly beseech you from the bottom of my heart to succor me in this necessity (make request). There are none that can withstand your power. O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee. Sweet Mother I place this cause in*
