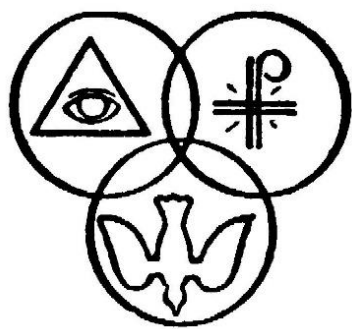

**A** **Mystery to me.** "It is a riddle, wrapped in a mystery, inside an enigma" This expression, originally used in 1939 by Winston Churchill, is typically used to describe something that is immensely puzzling or too complex to understand. The word "mystery" is often used in everyday speech. When we can't wrap our heads around something, we shrug and say "It's a mystery to me", or "It's another of life's great mysteries". As a child I used to wonder about the religious meaning of "mystery". If something is a mystery it can never be fully understood, though that does not mean we should stop trying – like Jesus being fully human and fully divine (the incarnation), Jesus' death and resurrection (the Paschal mystery) and three persons in one God (the Trinity). It is this last mystery that we celebrate today. In today's Gospel, we see that Jesus is comfortable with an element of mystery. He does not reveal everything to his disciples at once, as it "would be too much for you now". The full truth will be revealed later, when the Spirit comes. The more we reflect, the more we pray, the more we are open to the Spirit, the more we will understand about the great mystery of God as love. *The Deep End*

**ORDINATION OF A NEW PRIEST FOR THE DIOCESE OF CLOGHER:** On Sunday 30 June at 3pm in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan, Deacon Kevin Connolly, from the Parish of Donagh, Co Monaghan, will be ordained to the Priesthood by Bishop Larry Duffy. Deacon Kevin is extending an open invitation to all to attend and participate in the ordination liturgy in the Cathedral on that day. On the following day, Monday 1 July, he will celebrate his first Mass in St Mary's Church, Glaslough at 7pm. Once again, everyone will be welcome. The ordination of a priest is a great event in the life of the diocese and for the parish community. As a diocese, we give thanks to God for the gift of priesthood itself and, especially, that Deacon Kevin has answered "Yes" to God's call to serve the people of God in our diocese. We pray that others will do likewise, so that, through priesthood, the diaconate, religious life and other ministries, they may build up the community of faith that is the Church and be witnesses to Christ in the world.
