Return to Public Attendance at Mass

There is still a lot of uncertainty as to how the return to attendance at Masses will work. I have left **a separate sheet** at the back of both Churches outlining how this will work from Monday 29th June. The guidelines will be reviewed regularly according to government advice. SUNDAY MASSES

10 seats will be reserved for the families marking a **Month's Memory or First Anniversary Mass**. It will not be possible to reserve seats for subsequent anniversaries.

Sunday Mass is a parish event – a gathering of the believing community on the Day of the Lord's Resurrection. While we commemorate our deceased relatives and friends at Sunday Masses, the Mass belongs to the baptised parish community as a whole. From now on Readers and Eucharistic Ministers will be chosen from the Parish Rotas for Sunday Masses. The only exception will be for Month's Memory and First Anniversary Masses.
