Fr. Peter McVerry SJ is a Jesuit Priest, Social Activist, Prison Chaplain, Author and Founder of the Peter McVerry Trust. He had ministered to homeless people and drug users in Dublin City for over 40 years.

He will share his experiences in the **Church of the Immaculate Conception, Newtownbutler on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> October at 7pm.** The talk is open to everyone and is free to attend. He will take questions from people who are concerned about local social issues and the ever-growing drug culture in modern day Ireland.
