KNOCK SHRINE:

Pope Francis has elevated the National Sanctuary of Our Lady of Knock to the status of an **International Shrine of Eucharistic and Marian Devotion**. Pope Francis described it as an “important moment in the life of the shrine” and “a great responsibility”. Praying tribute to the Irish faithful he said “ *You have been a missionary people. We cannot forget how many priests left their homeland in order to become missionaries of the Gospel. Nor can we forget the many lay people who immigrated to faraway lands but still kept their devotion to Our Lady*”
