NORMS FOR INDULGENCES AT THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL SOULS

1 From 12 o'clock noon on 1 November until Midnight on 2 November all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Popes intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary or any other prayer of ones' choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 November – 8 November.

2 The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1 – 8 November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
