All Ireland Rosary Rally - Knock - Saturday, June 1st: Join thousands of people from around Ireland and beyond for the All Ireland Rosary Rally on June 1st. The day begins at 9.30am with a Conference in St. John's Centre. There is a chance to meet over 20 apostolates from around Ireland in St John Centre from 11.30am. The keynote speaker, Mother Adela Galindo, is coming from Miami, Florida, and she will speak in the Basilica at 1pm. The Stations of the Cross will be outside from 2pm, followed by the Rosary procession. Mass will commence at 3pm in the Basilica and will include the anointing of the sick. Bishop Phonsie Cullinan will be the Main Celebrant. Dana will join the choir to sing. There will also be rosary and scapular making workshops in the marquee. The St. Rita Novena Prayer: Feast 22 May

O God, in your infinite tenderness you have been pleased to regard the prayer of your servant Rita, and to grant to her supplication that which is impossible to human foresight, skill and effort, as rewards for her compassionate love and firm reliance on your promises. Have pity on us in times of adversities and comfort us in our calamities, that even the unbelievers may know that you are the recompense of the humble, the defence of the helpless, and the strength of those who trust in you. Grant this in the name of Jesus the Lord. *St. Rita (1386 – 1457) was married for 18 years to an ill tempered and abusive man who was murdered. Later Rita entered the Augustinian convent in Cascia and spent 40 years in prayer and charity. She is patron saint of the impossible and hopeless causes.*
