Pope Francis recently recognised the miracle attributed to Blessed Carlo Acutis and cleared the path for his canonisation. Happiness broke out around the world at the prospect of seeing the so-called 'cyberapostle' and 'influencer of God' become the first millennial saint.

Who was Carlo? Carlo was a teenager who led a normal life. He went to school, played video games, practised sports and spent time with friends and family. His secret was his love for the Eucharist. He spent many hours in front of the tabernacle and nurtured a close relationship with Jesus and Mary.

He would go out of his way to talk to a homeless person and to help the poor. He was passionate about computers and dedicated hours to creating websites that would help spread the message of God's love to the world. His example and words brought many of his friends and family closer to God. He died at the age of fifteen from leukaemia.
